Journey to Justice aims to inspire and empower people to take action for social justice through learning from human rights movements: www.journeytojustice.org.uk

The **Journey to Justice mobile exhibition** tells extraordinary stories of 'ordinary' men, women and children involved in the civil rights movement and links that universal history to UK struggles for freedom. Using photography, text, audio-visual features, poetry, music and interactive installations, the exhibition explores the question, 'What leads people to be active in social justice campaigns of all types?' As the exhibition travels around the UK we partner with local communities to run a programme of arts and education events, telling local stories of fighting for freedom, equality and human rights. We show how change for social justice can happen led by 'people like us'.
